We take **gift cards and supplies as well!** The items we need most often are **diapers** (all sizes), **wipes**, toiletries for both mom and baby (body wash, lotion, deodorant, exc), women and **baby clothes**, breastfeeding supplies (nipple pads, milk storage bags, nipple cream), exc. Many of our clients are single moms, often starting over from scratch and don't have much, so there isn't much we turn down. We do ask that the items be good quality (no hotel toiletries, exc) because it is important, we do not give the impression we believe just because they have nothing, they'll accept anything. GRAAUW PUBLIC POLICY UPDATE FEBRUARY 2023

Thank you to all of you who participated in contacting your legislators during this busy General Assembly session. As of this writing the General Assembly session has ended and now the Budget needs to be finalized. There have been several bills concerning Abortion, Paid Family Medical Leave, Paid Sick days and Education funding that many of you responded to me about your concerns. Luckily the Senate has been able to block many bills that we were concerned about especially concerning abortion access and education public school funding. However, there were many bills that we wanted to see address AAUW issues that were either tabled or killed in either the Senate or House.

Special thanks go to **Kathy Kelley, Barb Strohman, and Carol Stephens** for attending AAUW-VA Lobby Day on January 18 at the General Assembly here in Richmond VA.

Thank you all in Congressional District 4 for getting out to vote in the special election held on February 21st. Virginia has voted in its very first Black Woman representative to the US Congress!

There will be a wrap up Zoom meeting by AAUW-VA Co VP Public Policy Chairs later in March for us to learn more about final outcomes of the bills we supported and opposed. Stay tuned for that announcement!

Thank you again for all your support and quick turn around to the many emails concerning bills that were coming up for vote in this General Assembly.

In November 2023, all 140 Virginia Senate and Delegate elected officials are up for election. It will be an important time for us to be active in the upcoming Virginia elections. With several elected officials deciding to retire namely Dick Saslaw, the majority Senate leader, we may see some real changes in leadership depending on the outcome of the 2023 Virginia election.
